

Red, White, and Blue Star Wreath

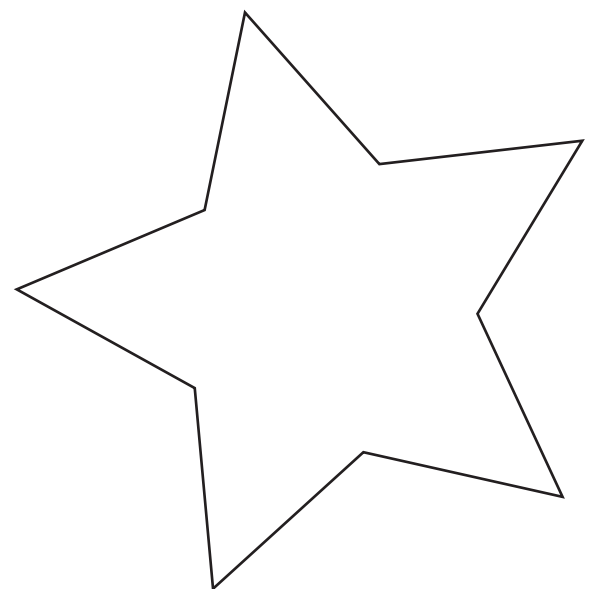
Supplies

paper plate	blue paper
scissors	red, white, and blue ribbons or crepe paper streamers (optional)
printer	glue
white paper	
red paper	



Instructions

1. Cut out the center of the paper plate, leaving a ring that is 1–2 inches wide. You may find it easiest to fold the plate in half to get started.
2. Print this page and cut out the star template. (If you have one, you could use a star-shaped cookie cutter instead.)
3. Trace the template on the red, white, and blue sheets of paper. You will need 5 or 6 of each color. You can also make stars that are different sizes, if you'd like.
4. Cut out the stars you traced.
5. Cut the ribbons or crepe paper streamers into strips 24–36 inches long. Glue them to the bottom of the wreath.
6. Place the stars on the rim of the plate, alternating red, white, and blue. Be sure they are spaced the way you want them before you glue them in place. Use the stars to cover the spot where you glued the streamers to the plate.
