

Georgia O’Keeffe–Inspired Flower

Supplies

Construction paper in a variety of colors

Scissors

Glue, glue stick, or tape

Real flowers for observation (optional)



Instructions

1. Spend some time looking closely at *Narcissa’s Last Orchid* by Georgia O’Keeffe. If you can, also spend some time looking at real flowers, noticing the different colors and shapes.
2. Choose one piece of construction paper as the background. Choose other colors for your flower.
3. Draw some shapes that look like the petals of a flower, and some shapes that look like the center, and cut them out.
4. Arrange the shapes on the paper you chose for your background and secure them in place using tape or glue.
